# Proposed Changes to Valley Quilters Guild By-Laws July 8, 2019

# **By-Laws Changes Proposed**

The Board recommends a change in the By-Laws regarding membership status. The proposed change would establish one level of membership in Article III-Membership, Section 1; delete Section 2; Section 3. Honorary Membership would now become Section 2.

The Board recommends the following:

# Page 11 Article III-Membership

"Section 1. Membership of the Guild shall be limited to one-hundred fifty (150) regular members over the age of sixteen (16) years. Membership dues, as set by the Executive Board, are payable by the *January* meeting. Membership dues are not refundable.

Members of the Guild are encouraged to attend monthly meetings, support philanthropic activities, work at the annual Quilt Show, may vote, hold office and will receive a copy of the yearbook and the newsletter."

## Page 12

"Section 2. Honorary Membership may be granted by the board in recognition of outstanding service to the Guild. Honorary membership will be valid for one year. Member will be exempt from paying dues, but will receive the newsletter and yearbook."

PAYMENT can be made by: cash (exact amount only), check, or credit card.




