



Block of the Month

Wedding Ring - June



Cutting and Piecing

- From Fabric A (background), cut six 2-7/8 inch squares; halve each square diagonally.
- From Fabric B, cut six 2-7/8 inch squares; halve each square diagonally.
 Sew pairs of Fabric A and B triangles together, forming twelve half-square triangle units.
- From Fabric C, cut two 2-7/8 inch squares; halve each square diagonally.
 From Fabric D, cut two 2-7/8 inch squares; halve each square diagonally.
- Sew pairs of Fabric C and D triangles together, forming four half-square triangle units.
- From Fabric A (background), cut five 2-1/2 inch squares.
- From Fabric D, cut four 2-1/2 inch squares.
- Assemble the block, using the diagram as a guide.

Your block should measure 10-1/2 inches square (unfinished size).


