President's Message



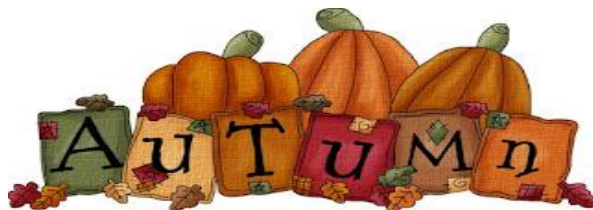


