AGREEMENT AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR DISPLAYING QUILTS

Please read before completing and signing entry form

The Valley Quilters are sponsoring this show for the pleasure of quilters and quilt lovers all over Southern California. We invite you to enter your quilt in our show, February 10 & 11, 2012. **All ENTRY FORMS must be received by December 1, 2011.** We request machine and hand quilted items only. **NO** tied quilts (except Crazy Quilts). We reserve the right to refuse any quilts that we consider to be in poor taste or inappropriate for our show. You will be notified if your Entry is not accepted. Please be sure to keep a copy of your entry form.

THE OWNER OF THE QUILT AGREES TO:

1. On all quilts 60" or wider, to hand sew below the upper back edge a 5" sleeve in which to insert a rod for hanging the quilt. Smaller quilts will be carefully pinned to a drape. Please be sure sleeve is secure.
2. Sew a fabric name tag on the quilt or other items for positive identification.

DELIVERY

Delivery of the quilt is the responsibility of the Owner. All items for display must be delivered to Valley Wide Recreation Center on **Wednesday Morning, February 8, 2012 between 8:30 A.M. and 11:30 A.M.**

No exceptions.

- **Include a photo of each entry and one photo of yourself.** (no larger than 4" by 6"). It will be added to the quilt entry information card that is displayed on the quilt.

PICK UP:

After the show on Saturday February 11, 2012, all entries must be picked up between 4:30 & 5:30 p.m. They will be handed out on a first come, first serve basis. If you have a problem, call Marvel Dorf.

Quilts will not be released without the receipt you were given on Wednesday. Please make sure you have a receipt for each item. No member or quilt owner will be allowed to remove his/her quilt from the display racks. The "Quilt Acquisitions Committee" will remove all quilts. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

Please read the following with care.

DEFINITIONS:

- Number of Entries** Limit three entries per person. Use a separate form for each entry. No entries will be accepted without a CURRENT Entry Form. Please remember the copyright laws. No tied quilts please.
- Large Quilts** Due to lack of space only TWO large Quilts (over 70 inches wide) per applicant will be accepted. Remember our largest rack is 108 inches. Anything larger will not hang as smoothly.
- Design Source** **Is a must.** Due to copyright laws you must give credit to the designer, name of pattern or other source.
- Photos** One photo of **each** entry *and* **one photo of yourself** (no larger than 4" x 6"). Please send both photos with entry form. Put your name and name of quilt on all photos.
- Pieced** Piecing predominates over appliqué and other techniques either in amount or effect. The quilt must be more than 90% pieced.
- Appliqué** Appliqué predominates over piecing or other techniques in amount or effect. The quilt must be more than 75% appliqué.
- Mixed** Any quilt that is a combination of piecing, appliqué and one or more other techniques.
- Other** Whole Cloth, Crazy Quilts, Yo-Yo, etc.
- Innovative Art** The entry is an art piece using an original design based on experiences, surroundings and ideas. May include innovative techniques.
- Miniatures** Quilt is 24" by 24" or less with miniature design. It must appear as a full size quilt, but in a much smaller scale. It is not a single block with borders.
- All Over Quilting** The same pattern all over the quilt (edge to edge quilting/pantograph)
- Free Motion Custom** Quilting/pattern is designed by the Longarm quilter.
- Computerized Custom** Quilting/pattern is quilted with a computerized longarm machine/software.
- Judging Category** Final decision will be made by the Quilt Acquisition Committee.
- Artist Statement** On the reverse side of the Entry Form please describe your entry, technique, and what inspired you to make this item in 35 words or less. This information will be printed on the information card along with a copy of the photo you enclosed. You have spent a great deal of time in making this entry. Please take the time to share your story.
- Entry Form** All entries must be accompanied by a CURRENT Entry Form. All other forms will be returned.
- Deadline** No Entry Forms will be accepted after **December 1, 2011.**

Please be sure your entries are clean and free of loose threads and pet hair.
