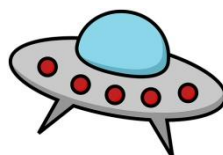

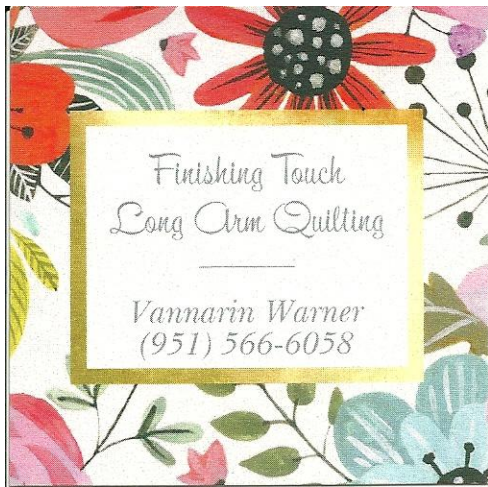

They must be completed and back to us on or before the December Guild Meeting so that we will have time to count out the number of sales tags you will require.
