

Grace Ward




One of the ideas of raising funds for the guild was to offer a CD with 40 block patterns that would create a beautiful quilt called **Women of the Bible**.

Kathy Ray has started this quilt and is on her way of putting the blocks together. See below.






Challenge Project-Storm at Sea Shirley Mykris


